

2023-2024 Catalog Addenda and Errata

The following addenda and errata were approved by the Academic and Student Services Committees on December 20, 2023.

Addenda:

Undergraduate Catalog Section 3.1.1. Remove the requirement for a bachelor's degree seeking student to submit a personal statement and remove the requirement for a government-issued photo identification for admission to USSA.

Undergraduate and Graduate Catalog Section 3.1.2. Add the following: "Satisfactory score on the Duolingo English Test (minimum score 100).

Undergraduate and Graduate Catalog Section 3.8 Clarify the language from "two consecutive terms" to "two consecutive semesters" and clarify in all instances of "consecutive terms" through the undergraduate and graduate catalogs.

Undergraduate Catalog Section 3.10.2 Add the following: "Duolingo scores can be sent by selecting USSA on the Duolingo testing site." Also add in the testing facilities and services.

Undergraduate Catalog Section 8.2.3. Add specific language for suspension as an action taken before dismissal, then clarify language regarding reinstatement after dismissal.

Undergraduate Catalog Section 3.1.1. A discussion concluded that the requirement for the entrance essay and the photo identification would be removed from the admissions section. These two requirements are still required at enrollment: Section 3.10.3 and Section 8.26, respectively.

Errata:

Graduate Catalog Section 4.4.3.6. Update language to clearly reflect practice "fee will be due yearly" rather than per semester.
